


EMI-SHIELDED COMPOSITE SHELTERS

Available in 8-, 9-, 12-, and 20foot variants, SelectTech EMI-Shielded Composite Shelters are designed and manufactured to provide electronic equipment storage and operational resources in austere and fixed locations per ICD-705 Requirements. Our Shelters are optimized for rapid integration of communication and electronics equipment to create a secure, rugged, portable, and quickly deployable sensitive compartmented information facility (SCIF) for challenging environments. The overall dimensions of the Composite Shelter can be customized during manufacturing to accomodate unique customer applications and support mission critical systems while providing the proper environment for continuous secure operation.

Features

Made from strong, lightweight fiberglass reinforced panels (FRP) with 4 embedded faraday shields molded into the wall panels. Floor and framing welded from aircraft grade 6061-T6 aluminum. Inserts can be molded into the wall and roof panels.

Options

Power and signal waterfall panels with customer specified mil-spec connectors, EMI power filters, secure communications circuits, pneumatic antenna masts, custom-designed environmental control units, and matched generator power. Full system integration to match mission requirements.

Characteristics

Panel Thickness: 2.250 Inches
